

COMPOUND SUBJECTS AND PREDICATES

A compound subject is a subject with two or more simple subjects.

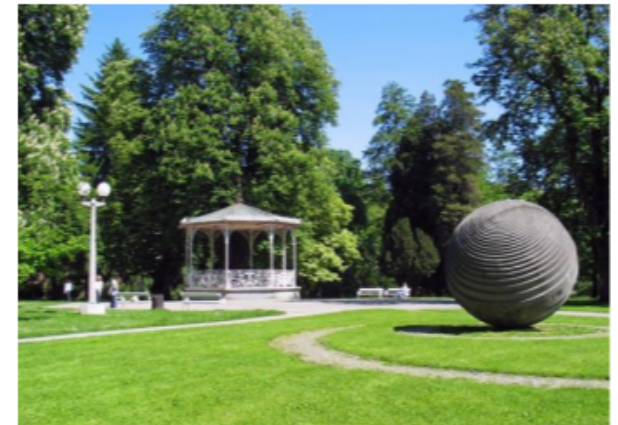
Examples:

Maria and I went to the park.

Susie and Laura like iCarly.

Men and women sing in the choir.

Teachers and students all do the fun run at AIAP.



COMPOUND SUBJECTS AND PREDICATES

A compound predicate is a predicate with two or more simple predicates.

Examples:

Duke ate his dinner and played outside.

Teacher Kyle ran 2 miles and went to football practice.

Teacher Rachel swam at the beach and ran for 30 minutes.

The students learned about grammar and had fun.
